

FARMERS UNION OIL OF CIRCLE & TERRY
SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The FUOC/SF will grant two non-renewable scholarships of \$1000 for the year 2010.

Each scholarship awarded will be sent to the appropriate authority at the college, university or vocational school of applicant's choice. Scholarships are only available to dependent children that are legal citizens of this country and current/members/customers of FUOC.

Recipients must meet the following requirements:

1. Be a full time student
2. Maintain a high school grade level of at least 2.6 (or equivalent)
3. Verify that their parent(s) is in good standing with FUOC.

Scholarship Application Procedures:

1. Applications must be submitted on or before the deadline date of April 1, 2010. The following information will be required of all applicants for the scholarship. The committee and FUOC will determine when revision is needed to the required information.
 - a. Name, address and phone number of the applicant; SAT, ACT or other standardized testing score; expected field of study; and the name of the college, university or vocational school where the applicant has enrolled or intends to enroll.
 - b. Transcript of high school records. Prior to funding of approved scholarship applicant will submit satisfactory completion of all high school graduation requirements.
 - c. A brief personal description that includes civic activities, extra curricular activities and employment history AND a 300 word essay on the subject of "Why I applied for a FUOC Scholarship Fund".
 - d. Two references from people other than family members. One may be from a friend of the family, employer, or an in the community; the second will be from a current or former school faculty member. These references must be mailed with the application.
 - e. If other applications have been offered to or accepted by the applicant, they must be disclosed on the application.
 - f. The name and address of the applicant's parent's must be supplied on the application.
2. Scholarships for only the students entering at the beginning of full term of study beginning in the fall.
3. The Scholarship Committee will review all applications. Scholarship recipients will be notified of their selection no later than July 15th.
4. If a committee member is related to the applicant he/she must recuse him/her from participating on the committee that year.
